Explore the early expansion of the city, racial and spatial discrimination, and working life in Cape Town at the Iziko Bo Kaap Museum. The Effendis of 71 Wale Street, Bo Kaap shares the untold story of the Effendi family who lived in the house, today the Bo Kaap Museum, before the forced removals of the 1970's. 71 Wale Street, Cape Town | Closed: Sundays, Eid-al Fitt; Eid-al Adha, Workers' Day, Christmas Day & 2 January.

F KOOPMANS-DE WET HOUSE (IKDW)

The oldest house museum in the country, Iziko Koopmans de Wet House was originally built as a home for a well-to-do Cape family during the late 18th century. 35 Strand Street, Cape Town | Closed: Saturday to Wednesday, Workers' Day & Christmas Day.

6 WILLIAM FEHR COLLECTION

The William Fehr Collection contains fine and interesting paintings and decorative arts of special relevance to the Cape's wealth of historical information – especially concerning peoples and landscapes of early colonial South Africa. The collection is exhibited at the Castle of Good Hope and Rust en Vreugd (see below), both historic buildings. Castle of Good Hope, Darling Street | Closed: Christmas Day & New Year's Day

H RUST & VREUGD

Rust en Vreugd was built as a home for Willem Cornelius Boers, a high-ranking official for the VOC (Dutch East India Company), between 1777 and 1778. Today a museum, it showcases a selection of William Fehr's collection of drawings, watercolours and print art works. 78 Buitenkant Street, Cape Town | Closed: Saturday to Wednesday, Workers' Day & Christmas Day.

I GROOT CONSTANTIA MANOR HOUSE Groot Constantia dates back to 1695, making it one of South Africa's oldest commercial wine farms. Not only does it boast an admirable exhibition of historical furniture and paintings but on display are historical wine cellars and drinking vessels.

It was from this wine farm that exiled French ruler Napoleon Bonaparte was supplied with his favorite wine. Groot Constantia is a treat for both locals as well as tourists. Groot Constantia Estate | Closed: Workers' Day & Christmas Day.
